**Invitation to Register for the HockeyHKWS 2025/26 Winter League**

Dear Club Convenors

Applications are now invited from Affiliated Clubs who wish to have teams considered for entry into the Hockey Hong Kong, China Women's Section 2025/26 Winter League.

Please complete the online registration form <https://forms.gle/wxoU65j9uq3JkWMf7> and ensure ***both payments are made separately*** on or before ***Thursday, 31 July 2025***.

The payments consist of (a) a Team Registration Fee for each team registered and (b) a Club Affiliation Fee for each club together with an administration fee for each team registered. These can be made by (i) two cheques made payable to "Hockey Hong Kong, China" or (ii) or two transfer payments to HSBC 658-117643-838 Hockey Hong Kong, China) to be made on or before ***Thursday, 31 July 2025*** and email evidence of such payments to [garychung@hockey.org.hk](mailto:garychung@hockey.org.hk) by such date. **In the same email**, please also advise any changes in kit design for the 2025/26 season.

**1/ FEES**

Fees for the forthcoming season payable by ***Thursday, 31 July 2025*** will be as follows:

<b>(A) League Fees</b> (Team Registration Fee)	<b>\$750 (<i>per team</i>)</b>
<b>(B) Administration Fees</b>	
(i) 100% of Club Affiliation Fee	\$750 ( <i>per club</i> )
PLUS	
(ii) 100% of Administration Fee	\$12,000 ( <i>per team</i> )

(A) and (B) must be made as two separate payments due to LCSD requirements.

***Please note that if a Club pays the above fees aggregated into a single payment, such payment will not be accepted by the HockeyHK.***

A fine of HK\$1,000 may be imposed on any Affiliated Club whose full affiliation and administration fees are not received by this date. Non-payment may also affect your right to commence your league games. Please note that this is a special payment term and this due date is final. Should you have any difficulties or would like to pay in instalments, please contact the HockeyHKWS at [garychung@hockey.org.hk](mailto:garychung@hockey.org.hk) and we may work out an arrangement suitable for circumstances.

Note that **ANY outstanding fines** incurred during the 2024/25 season **MUST be paid** on or before 23 July 2025 or your Affiliated Club may not be accepted for entry in the 2025/26 Winter League.

## 2/ SQUAD SIZE

The minimum number of players that may be registered in a team is 15 players. Should you have any concerns about meeting this requirement please contact the HockeyHK by **1pm on Thursday, 31 July 2025** so that the Committee may consider any potential dispensations on a case by case basis prior to the payment deadline.

- Should you wish to register more than 22 players in a squad, you may do so (for any team) provided that you pay an amount of HK\$300 per player. However, please note that we shall not accept more than 30 players registered for a single squad.

### **3/ KIT**

If you are a new club or your team(s) kit is different from last season please send an email to [garychung@hockey.org.hk](mailto:garychung@hockey.org.hk) with the designs and colours of the 2 sets of playing uniform (including socks, skirts/skorts/shorts and shirts) on or before **Thursday, 31 July 2025** for committee's approval.

It is important that your second strip is in complete contrast to your first strip, including your socks. Please note that white socks are NOT ENCOURAGED. A fine of \$500 shall be imposed for Affiliated Clubs who do not advise their second strip.

### **4/ NO PLAY DATE**

Given the closure of King's Park and our goal to play two full rounds, we regret that we will be unable to accommodate any "no play dates" from the clubs this season. Should you have any difficulties, you may consider requesting postponement of matches. Postponement will be handled in accordance with Competition Bye-laws 11.9 and 11.10.

### **5/ WALKOVERS**

Should your team be in a situation that they declare a walkover, please note that fines apply and we would like to draw your attention to Bye-law 11.6 of the HockeyHKWS Competition Bye-laws.

Please be reminded that walkovers are not encouraged and will automatically result in Affiliated Clubs being fined and potentially subject to other penalties as set out in the Competition Bye-laws.

Should one of your teams have an insufficient number of players (i.e. less than 8), please inform the HockeyHKWS as soon as possible by email (with an explanation as required by the above Bye-law) **and** by telephone – preferably by 1.00 pm on the Friday before the Saturday game and by 1.00 pm on the day before a mid-week game.

In the event of a walkover being given, umpiring duties are still to be undertaken if the team has an assigned duty and fines shall be applied for no-shows. It is your duty to ensure that everyone knows that the game is not taking place and to notify the following:

- Captain of the opposition,
- Club Convenor for team you are giving walkover to,
- Club Convenors for teams that may have an umpiring duty for the game that is being cancelled.

### **6/ CLUB CONVENORS' MEETING**

A pre-season Club Convenors' meeting is scheduled on **13 August 2025** at 7:30 pm at King's Park. Details will be sent out separately together with a Convenors' Circular.
