PRESIDENT'S REPORT

New Stadium

- Government advised that, according to the approved Contamination Assessment Plan for land contamination assessment for the Project, further detailed site investigation work will be required to be conducted to the whole Project site to assess the nature and extent of land contamination. The technical feasibility of the project is being assessed so as to determine the most appropriate way forward. At this stage, there is no implementation schedule for the Project.

Website Revamp

- New website's layout is finalized and compatible mobile view will be available. Player registration and E-match card system undergoes the final testing phase. Convenors are required to update the unique personal email of the registered players in the current registration for migration. Otherwise, they could not be activated in the new system once launched. The course enrollment system is still developing.

Asian Games

- We are disappointed that both our Men's and Women's team did not qualify for the 20th Asian Games.
