Note: (1) If there are any outstanding documents, details or fees, the application will not be processed.

(2) The forms, ID and passport copy as well as photos should be clear and in good resolution.

**** Player's photos requirement: passport size photo (shoulder shown) with minimum resolution of 300dpi under 250kb in size. ****

(3) For local players who are above 18-year-old and DO NOT have any change of team and shirt number for the new season, we have changed their status in the registration system for re-registration. Once the re-registration application is submitted by the club online, it will be deemed as final submission and Hockey Hong Kong, China will approve accordingly.

Those applications with missing or inappropriate sized player's photo will not be accepted.

**** Other special requests e.g. re-registration of shirt # change, U18 player and visiting player, Form B must be completed; transfer of player, Form C will need to be completed.*

(4) Applications that have been approved online by the Hockey Hong Kong, China will become invalid in case the corresponding forms for these special requests are absent. MS reserves the right to impose penalties to the respective clubs according to the bye-laws.

(5) No changes of player details (e.g. shirt no., team or status) will be allowed once the player is registered unless the clubs have received approval from the Hockey Hong Kong, China. I understand that any incorrect details submitted may results in delay in processing.

(6) The first registration deadline before the start of the new season will be 5pm on 15 August, 2025 (Fri). The weekly cut-off dates for additional player registration or changes in players information will be at 5:00pm on every Wednesday unless it falls on public holiday (deadline will be postponed to Thursday 5pm). Registrations that are received after the deadline will only be processed after the Hockey Hong Kong, China Men's Section completed the processing of those applications which are submitted on time.

(6) Players cannot play any game unless they are listed on the Player List (for umpire verification) or penalty will be imposed according to the byelaws.
